January 1 – February 19, 2023

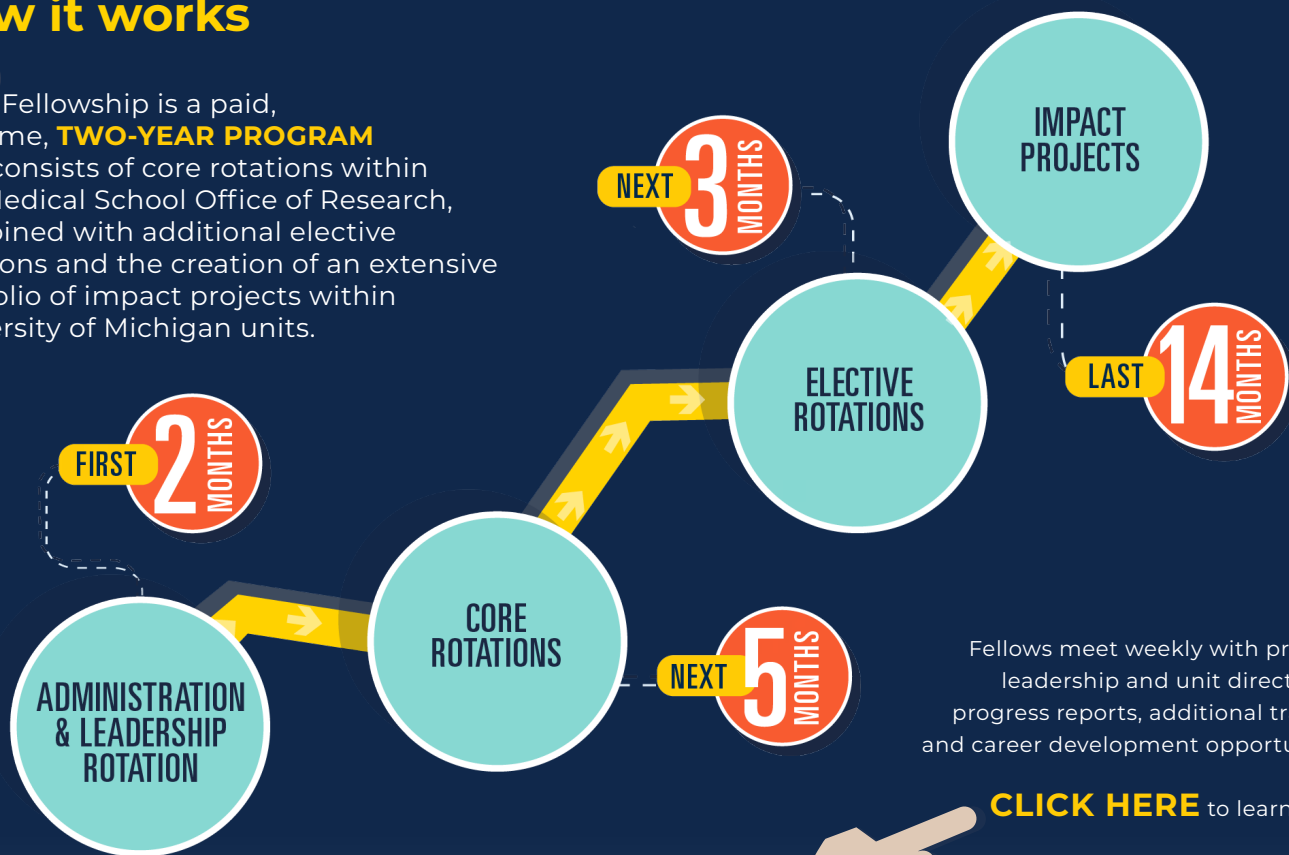
### Fellowship begins:
